Clean Paper Belongs in Your Blue Recyclables Cart

- Contain shredded paper in a paper bag or box.
- Remove the plastic bag from your newspaper. Reuse the bag or place it in the garbage.
- Flatten and/or cut down boxes.
- Remember that only clean boxes belong in your blue cart.

ORGANICS



Food-Soiled Paper Belongs in Your Green Organics Cart

- Takeout Containers
- Napkins and Towels
- Plates & Cups
- Pizza Boxes
- Remember that Styrofoam® takeout containers belong in your gray **garbage** cart. Choose reusable, recyclable or compostable alternatives whenever possible.

Help Us Provide Clean & Efficient Service With a Proper Cart Set Out

- Be sure your carts are at the curb, facing the street, by 6:00 am on your collection day. Log into your account or contact us to find out when we service your area.



- Leave the carts at the curb until we've emptied them. **Our trucks may arrive at different times each week.**
- Overflow garbage will only be collected if you have affixed a pre-paid tag to your trash bag. Call ACI to purchase tags or to arrange for additional service.

- Carts need to be placed with space between them so that the automated truck arm can service them properly. **If possible, try to leave 3 feet between each cart.**



- Do not place carts too close to parked cars, fire hydrants, low-hanging branches, parking meters, utility poles and other obstacles.
- Do not overload your carts. The lids should close completely.
- Do not wedge or compact materials into your carts. Doing so will prevent your cart from being fully emptied when serviced.

The Reusable Bag Law is Expanding!


Beginning May 1, all retail stores in Alameda County can only distribute recycled content paper and compliant reusable bags. A minimum price of 10 cents per bag must be charged and itemized on the receipt. Residents who find local stores not following the expanded law should contact: **Bags@StopWaste.org** or **510-891-6575**.



The Reusable Bag Law is designed to reduce waste and keep plastic bags out of local waterways. Since 2013, there has been a 44% decrease in plastic bags found in Alameda County storm drains! For more information, visit: **www.ReusableBagsAC.org**.
