In Alameda County, proper sorting of waste is mandatory. Alameda businesses and multi-family residential properties must have an appropriate level of **Recyclables** and **Organics** collection service in place. Your blue **Recyclables** carts and bins are for bottles, cans, papers, and boxes. Your green **Organics** carts and bins are for food scraps, food-soiled paper products, and yard trimmings such as grass and flower clippings. We thank you for all your efforts and encourage you to recycle and compost even more.
